In Spring 2023 BC Hockey will announce the list of 50-80 high performance athletes who make the [Team BC U18 Program of Excellence Summer ID Camp](#). For those athletes who make this list, the West Coast Hockey Prep Camp is preparing a customized preparation program. As dates may interfere with our Week 1 and Week 2 of camp, we are starting this group in advance of Week 1 and ending in time to have a few days off before the Team BC U18 ID summer program begins.

Logistics

- ***Tentative Date: July 14 - 18, 2023** (Our Week 1: July 17-21, 2023). **Schedule subject to small changes once BC Hockey announces program.*
 - ½ Day Friday, Saturday - Monday, ½ Day Tuesday (8 ice times vs. 10 ice times in reg camp)
- **Modified Cost:** \$1200 (Tuition, Room and Board)
- **Who qualifies?** Only available for those that make the U18 BC ID Camp the following weekend. If you don't make it, you are welcome to attend Week 1 and/or 2!
- **Not sure if your daughter will make it?** Join on the monthly payment plan for now until the list is announced. Total camp fees will be adjusted as necessary.
- **Transportation:** We can help get athletes from camp to the ferry in Nanaimo at the end of this modified camp Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday depending on your family logistical requirements. We will customize their schedule if they need to stay longer than the scheduled end date (\$55 Transportation fee).
